OPĆE INFORMACIJE

S današnjim danom, 04.05.2020., u Republici Hrvatskoj potvrđeno je 2.101 slučajeva zaraze koronavirusom, od čega se 1.522 osoba oporavilo, a preminulo je 80 osoba.

U Istarskoj županiji, s današnjim danom, nema oboljelih od koronavirusa. Prethodno je evidentirano 90 slučajeva zaraze i 2 preminule osobe.

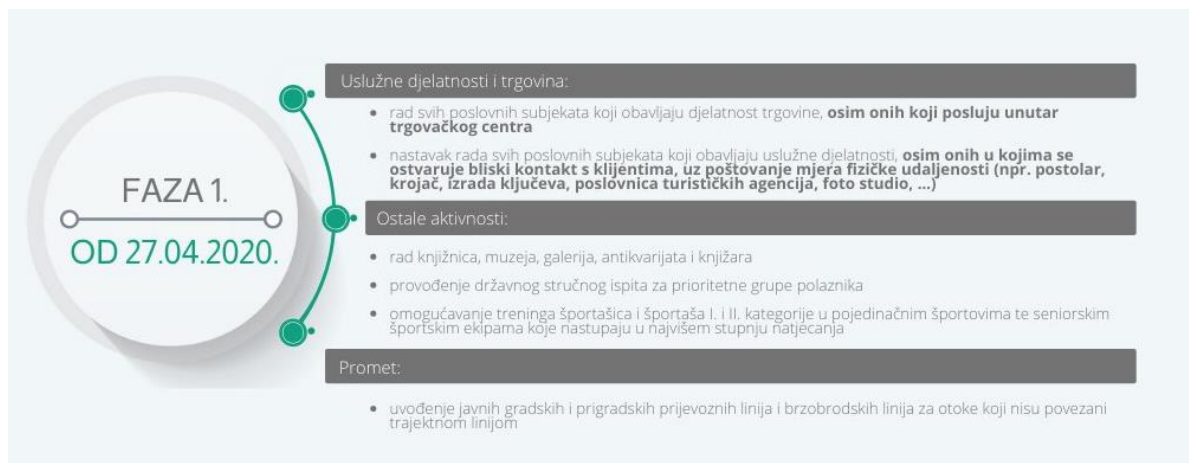
MJERE I ODLUKE

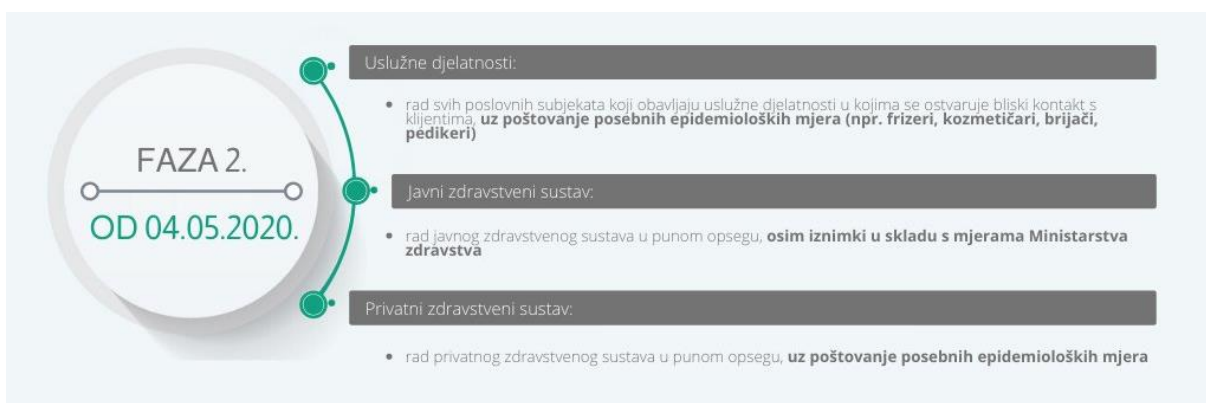
Sve odluke Stožera civilne zaštite RH za sprečavanje širenja zaraze koronavirusom možete pronaći [OVDJE](#).

Odlukom Stožera civilne zaštite RH od 20.04.2020. omogućeno je kretanje građana unutar Istarske županije bez e-Propusnica, što znači da se građani mogu slobodno kretati unutar granica Istarske županije, a e-Propusnica je potrebna samo za odlazak na područje druge županije.

Odlukom Stožera civilne zaštite Republike Hrvatske, trenutno je na snazi Odluka o privremenoj zabrani prelaska preko graničnih prijelaza Republike Hrvatske koja se primjenjuje do 18. svibnja 2020. Prvobitna [ODLUKA](#) donesena je 19. ožujka 2020. koja se primjenjivala 30 dana te je 18. travnja 2020. donesena [ODLUKA O IZMJENAMA](#), kojom se odluka o privremenoj zabrani prelaska preko graničnih prijelaza RH produžuje **do 18. svibnja 2020.**

Ponovno pokretanje gospodarskih i drugih aktivnosti odvijat će se u tri faze. S današnjim danom, 04.05.2020., došlo je do druge faze te se očekuje daljnje popuštanje treće faze s datumom 11.05.2020.

GENERAL INFORMATION

On this day, 04 May 2020, Croatia has 2.101 confirmed cases of COVID-19, of which 1.522 people recovered. There are 80 confirmed deaths.

Istria County is now „corona-free zone“. 90 cases of COVID-19 infection have been reported previously and 2 deaths.

MEASURES AND DECISIONS

[HERE](#) you can find all the decisions of The Croatian Civil Protection Headquarters in order to prevent the spread of COVID-19, but only in Croatian.

By Decision of The Croatian Civil Protection Headquarters from 20 April 2020., citizens are allowed to move within the Istria County without e-passes (official permits), which means that citizens can move freely within Istria County, and e-pass is only required to go to the territory of another Croatian County.

By decision of The Croatian Civil Protection Headquarter, the Decision on the temporary prohibition of the border crossings of the Republic of Croatia is currently in force until **18 May 2020**.

The Croatian government has announced an initial three step relaxation of lockdown measures.

In first step, from 27 April 2020, small shops, libraries, museums, galleries have been permitted to open and public transport is once again in operation.

From 04 May service providers, such as hairdressers are allowed to work again and also public health system is operating again.

The third step intended to come into force from 11 May 2020 will allow shopping centres, kindergartens, national parks and nature parks to open. Meeting of up to 10 persons will be permitted and cafes and restaurants will be allowed to operate if customers are served outside.
